

ATHENS VILLAGE BOARD MEETING MINUTES
June 26, 2019

Pledge to the Flag

Present: Mayor Stephan Bradicich, Trustee Gail Lasher, Trustee Amy Serrago, and Trustee Robbie Scott. Absent: Trustee Dr. Joshua Lipsman

Public Hearing: The Mayor read the notice that was published in the newspaper announcing the public hearing for tonight on repealing local law #3 which provided an override of the tax cap for the fiscal year June 1, 2019 to May 31st, 2020.

There was no public comment.

A RESOLUTION to repeal local law #3 was made by Trustee Gail Lasher, seconded by Trustee Amy Serrago and all were in favor.

CLOSE PUBLIC HEARING

The regular board meeting was then opened

PUBLIC:

1. Mr. Walsh-Concern on Constantine Court

William Walsh was present to speak about an issue on Constantine Court. He said he has been living on Constantine Court for 2 years and the Green House has a south wall collapsed with water in the basement, which is a hazard for children, and the grass has not been cut. He wanted to know who handles this problem. The board said it was code enforcements job. Mr. Walsh also stated the Brown house across the street has been vacant and it too has high grass and water in the basement. He said that in April someone was there to pump out the basement and at some point they came and cut half the grass.

Mayor Bradicich said that a violation was written on the green house and he had been speaking to code enforcement on a number of issues.

Mayor Bradicich said that we would get the grass cut.

Mr. Walsh said that the village code enforcement needs to show and get this done. House on Union Street should be condemned it needs to come down.

Mayor Bradicich said there is a process.

Mr. Walsh said on 385 there are mansions being built—what about Constantine Court? Why wasn't this taken care of 2 years ago?

If Athens doesn't have a mower the town has a new one get one from them.

Mayor Bradicich said that it can take up to 6 months to see if owner does anything. As Mr. Walsh questioned why a complaint was made 2 years ago and nothing had been done.(the green house)

2. Bruce Pruiksmas-Speeding

Bruce Pruiksmas was present to speak about the speeding issue. He said he had a few more things to add from the last time he was present. He had a request to lower the speed, which he said Peter had given him all the requests that were made. He said he was very upset because you said you had no notices. Peter said all the requests went to DOT. He said that Peter also sent him a series of communications with something to do on Second Street. He said it's insane that people do 40mph.

Trustee Serrago said that Second Street is out of control lately.

Mr. Pruiksmas said that there was a response back to Peter on the letter addressing the issue for Murderers Creek on North and there was one complaint south by the lighthouse where they start to go 55. Mr. Pruiksmas handed out copies for everyone.

Mayor Bradicich said he spoke with Rob and he is addressing the concerns going south to Catskill.

Mr. Pruiksmas said that everyone needs to work together on this Rob, Ed Bloomer everyone. That is the problem no one wants to work together. Gene Hatton who passed away was the Greene County Legislator and had letters on all this, letters from people from the south and north of me and I know Ed Bloomer is a big time safety guy. We gotta get together to make something happen. I am very concerned that you say no letters were sent.

Trustee Lasher said that she could answer one question and that is that the board was never given copies of what Peter gave to DOT.

Mr. Pruiksmas said that the man meant well on this and why nothing is coming from DOT. I am doing this because I'm trying to improve that quality of living in this village and this town. I am not just concerned with what is going on in front of my house. There is a speeding problem in this County Greg Seeley has said he has had it with trying to do something about it. We hardly ever see the Athens Police. It isn't just me and the house to the south there are other residents like River Road we all pay taxes, but where is the Athens Police Department?

Mayor Bradicich said we are very limited (inaudible)

Mr. Pruiksmas said he has seen the budget and he knows there is not a lot of money but we have police cars and a chief of police and we need to do it right

Mayor Bradicich said the surveys came back and it is a low risk for speeding in that area.

Mr. Pruikisma said that 13 miles over the speed limit is not good.

Trustee Serrago said that lowering the speed limit is a start, but there is speeding on Second Street to Schoharie as well. I see one report from DOT here where they denied lowering the speed limit. The biggest problem is enforcement and the red tape with DOT and the county but first and foremost is enforcing.

Pruikisma said the least qualified drivers are the ones speeding. Always remember that . I'm not angry at anyone here. I am angry at the situation. Back in the day you just didn't speed here. All I know is there is a real problem and I don't want to see anyone hurt or killed. There is a real problem pulling out of River Road.. One thing I did do is send DOT a document that the signage is bad on 385. Ask Pete Alberti what it is like to pull a dump truck loaded up the incline and make a left hand turn out of there. Its' not just Athens fatalities are up. It starts here in the Village of Athens, lets do something about it. Has anything been done about someone getting a ticket and the town of Athens gets the money.

Mayor Bradicich said we don't maintain our own court system in the village any more.

Pruikisma asked why no one has discussed with town splitting fines 50\50 since we pay for the cars. And everyone lives in Athens why are we not splitting.

Trustee Lasher said this is regulated by the state.

Pruikisma asked what is the sense in having a police department if they cannot write a ticket.

Trustee Lasher said its regulated by the state
They can write tickets.

Trustee Scott said the State makes the laws it is not local

Pruikisma asked if anyone has changed this.

Trustee Scott said you would have to have legislation to pass

Pruikisma said he wants to know why the Town doesn't take over the operation of the cars if we aren't taking care of the problems on the roads it is stupid. We have texting, speeding and no seatbelts.

Trustee Serrago said it is a problem in every municipality. Other than directing the police to concentrating on areas such as sitting near your home I don't know what I can do sitting in this seat right here. No one wants to see anyone get hurt or killed. Maybe direct our police to monitor the situation in areas where they are needed more. Right now there

is a counter in front of my house on Second Street, they are always collecting data. I don't know what they do with it.

Mayor Bradicich said we can get the data when we do surveys it helps to set priorities, our police force is small, they are here for music in the parks, the school, street festival. Community day and the presence of public relations it's not about speeding.

Pruiksma said I get that. Clean up the little stuff and the big stuff goes away.

Mayor Bradicich said I don't disagree with you. I think where you and I are disagreeing is what constitutes (in audible)

Pruiksma said stop being liberal with the speeds and get Athens back to the way it was. When these speeds are way up it's because there is no fear of consequences for it that is why it is going on. It endangers so many people. Im ready to do what Larry does, I'm going to tape and put up on the Internet and show people doing 69 mph. Peter knows about this subject he works it everyday. So does this guy (Trustee Scott) why don't you consult with Peter? Peter told me you have not contacted him and you assured me you were going to. That is very disappointing to me.

Mayor Bradicich said I told you I was going to speak with Rob about this

Pruiksma said I told you, would you like me to speak with Peter and you said you were going to yourself. I am completely serious about this subject. When Peter took office in 2017 there were a lot of accidents.

Mayor Bradicich said I understand I have data that the police kept that tell me that I don't have a problem and I don't hear about it from anyone else. So I'm not saying I'm not going to do anything I'm just trying to understand how I can justify (inaudible)

Pruiksma said let me respond to the one thing you said. The Athens Police Department does not use radar correctly. I know it sounds ridiculous and I explained this 2 months ago.

The village bears the cost of the cars and writes the tickets and the Town gets the money I don't think this is right.

We should be compensated just like the fire department the police car goes into the Town sometimes. I saw this guy (trustee Scott) go down River Road, I don't see it anymore they don't sit in my driveway any more, is it retaliation for bringing this stuff up?

Mayor Bradicich said it's based on prioritization studies that were done.

Pruiksma said I just want to make it clear there is a problem. I don't want to see anyone killed or hurt. I'm taking this serious Stephan I want to make this completely clear. Mr. Styles is taping and putting this up so people watch. Another suggestion is a fundraiser to help with this I'm never a person to criticize and I have seen this in my travels, why not

signs as you enter the Village of Athens. Welcome to Athens mv law strictly enforced. What would be wrong with that?

Mayor Bradicich said it's a question of, is that the number one priority as we drive into Athens? I don't know if it is.

Pruiksma said Speeding and all that is not a top priority?

Mayor Bradich said I didn't say it wasn't a high priority if that's the one thing we are going to put on a sign should that be it?

Pruiksma said I would why not? The drugs coming into this county are simply mind boggling Stephan. Seeleys guys pull people over all day. The more cars pulled over the better chance of keeping it form our children and veterans

Mayor Bradicidh said I hear you. I don't have an answer for you right now. I want to get a safety committee going and put you on it and see where priorities need to be. I don't mean to sound dismissive

Pruiksma you do

Mayor Bradicich said what I want is to get some data, some information and some understanding of what the priorities are from a safety stand point. I understand your standpoint from in front of your home but Id like to get community wide how we prioritize. I will try to put that safety committee together and get some information.

Pruiksma stated people are speeding all over but remember what I said the ones speeding are the one least qualified to do so. I can prove that, that's what makes it so scary. There is even speeding on Constantine court. I know a guy that lives there.

Gene Hatton had it with the speeding on Howard Hall he has passed worked hard on project at the end of Howard Hall Bloomer does not take speeding lightly and I believe we need to get him and Rob Butler involved. I love this village and I first moved here in 1957 I want safety and quality of life for everyone in this village. I am not doing this specifically or solely for myself.

I am not angry at anyone here, I am a little disappointed in you Stephan that you did not follow through and talk to Peter, because he is a wealth of knowledge whether you like him or not and talking to him would be beneficial. Ask him about pulling out of River Road in a truck.

Everyone thanked Mr. Pruiksma for coming.

3.Kathy Jackson—Library

The library applied for multiple grants to make the library handicap accessible and one of the grants was a matching funds grant. When the library was built there was money put into an acct . There were CDs that Tal said the money is available to us.

Mayor Bradicich asked how much was there.

Kathy quoted an amount. The CDs came due last year.

(Inaudible)

We applied for the grant and were supposed to start construction 180 days after receiving but we have not received the money yet. We have to use any money we have first and we are waiting for the final approval from the planning board.

Mayor Bradicich doesn't see any reason not to do a motion

Attorney Rappelyea said that was why a letter was written

A **Motion** to turn the CD account over to the library was offered by Trustee Lasher, Seconded by Amy Serrago all were in favor .

Trustee Serrago asked Kathy Jackson about complaints she has received about the wifi being left on and people using late at night. Amy wondered if it could be turned off at a certain time

Kathy Jackson said it cannot be turned off the people that complained to the library were told to call the police if people were disturbing others. People come in and use the internet to apply for jobs etc. But it cannot be controlled as they provide a service 24/7 because of the needs.

Mayor Bradicich said the funds would be released once Mary Jo is notified

4. Tracey Ledder from Delaware Engineering

Mayor Bradicich stated a resolution will need to be passed. (Brown field Project)

Tracey Ledder said she would need a copy of this when it is in the paper, it can be sent as a PDF

Mayor Bradicich said someone asked whether labeling a property a Brownfield impacts their property

Tracey said it does but not labeling it a Brownfield does as well.

Mayor Bradicich spoke with Mark Alexander from Wappingers Falls it impacts 1 mile .Then I spoke with Rene at the IDA and then got feedback from Vinnie Seeley as Catskill has one from the railroad tracks all the way to the point . All of them speak very highly of it. It helps get money for planning work, which Tracey and me can talk about in a minute. (Inaudible phone ringing)

Tracey said one of the things to look at would be the scope of work that would be passed that is part of the application. The nomination study requires this. You'll be funded to do this with the planning board, once designated as a BOA you will get more places to study as well as what do you want the water front and mains street to look like. How are you going to get there and prioritize and then you have access to do. Investors have to let the bank know what the bank is funding. Some information has to be given to the bank because their fear is foreclosing. With the BOA you can choose which ones you would like to see developed. A lot of work and participation is involved and a consultant will collect all of what is necessary. Need a lot of public participation in the study; part of the application is the commitment. We don't need to do a resolution tonight we can wait as we go through the public comment period. Hopefully we get participation.

Mayor Bradicich asked if the public hearing was on July 10th and one would be at the counter.

Tracey said it is 144 pages long. Tracey said Mary Jo would put this on the website as well. The mapped area is required to have 25 percent of properties mapped.

Mayor Bradicich asked if there were any questions and he had the documentation there if anyone wanted to take a look at it.

Tracey said the resolution that I sent to Mary Jo was changed to say go forward with it. This is a requirement from the board to move ahead.

Mayor Bradicich read the resolution (see Attached)

Greene County Health Department

Attorney Rappelyea stated that this notice is the same as what others have received. The Legislator passed a law for people to have vaccinations if enrolled they need proof. If they don't have it the Health Department can give for free.

Stephan asked does she have proof of the vaccinations, they can get free –good idea, does she have the paperwork to keep track of it all? Do we have all our counselors?

Trustee Scott said we have 6 returning and 4 new hires.

Mayor Bradicich told the clerk to let Code Enforcer Ragaini know
The village can do as they have a mower

Trustee Scott said they just got new blades on the mowers

Attorney Rappelyea said that he also received another complaint by mail over the Coons property.

Trustee Scott told the board this property is on Schoharie Turnpike and is a retaining wall between 2 properties that is falling and compromising Anthony Coons foundation and I have a copy of the property map from Peter Alberti and it shows specifically its on the neighbors property. It's the first house on the right. Trustee Scott went over the map with property line with the board. Trustee Scott said I think Coons got an attorney.

Attorney Rappelyea said yes he did.

Inaudible

Trustee Bradicich asked how far the foundation was from the wall.
Trustee Scott said probably 20 feet

Trustee Lasher asked if this would be the Villages responsibility?

Attorney Rappelyea said only if Code Enforcer Ragaini finds it to be a code violation, if not it's between the homeowners. I did say I would bring this to the boards attention. Trustee Scott said that Peter Alberti had an aerial picture because Anthony Coons brought to my attention a week ago, I didn't bring the aerial picture tonight. The wall sits on the neighbor's property, the map is from The Real Property Tax map it's an official document-the neighbors are probably going to be responsible for taking care of it. I didn't tell him anything either way just said I would bring it up.

Mayor Bradicich said he will talk to Mike Ragaini about this, this week.

Mayor Bradicich asked about the street light.

Trustee Scott said he talked to Marla about that today.

Trustee Serrago said I looked at it when I was walking the other day. Seems like the streetlights are close together.

Trustee Scott said there is a dark pocket.

Trustee Lasher asked if this is the villages responsibility to make sure that everybody's house is lit or is the homeowners responsible to put an outside light on.

Attorney Rappelyea said it is not the villages responsibility.

Trustee Lasher asked if Mayor Bradicich remembers this issue being discussed.

Mayor Bradicich said no.

Trustee Scott said he was told a resolution was passed.

Clerk said I believe there was a resolution passed because when I first started MaryJo had me call Central Hudson and I left 3 messages and a man returned 1 call and never returned the rest.

Mayor Bradicich asked what was the resolution that was passed?

Clerk I will have to look it up

Trustee Lasher asked Attorney Rappelyea if Central Hudson could be forced.

Attorney Rappelyea said we can't but we can contact them.

Trustee Serrago asked could we contact them about the new poles that left the streets a mess?

Clerk do you want me to pull the old resolution this week?

Mayor Bradicich yes so that I can take a look at that.

Trustee Lasher said she doesn't care if one goes up, but there is one on the corner

Trustee Serrago said there is one by Bernards house and there is one on the other side of the street half way up I don't know if Central Hudson will put it so close

Trustee Lasher said then you might have people complain that its too luminated.

Trustee Serrago said maybe get a porch light

Mayor Bradicich said for the clerk to send him the resolution and the contact info from the past. He said he like to see the wording of the resolution. He then asked if there was a rule on streetlights or spacing for the village?

Mayor Bradicich asked what the next complaint was

Trustee Lasher said Peckham

Mayor Bradicich said he needs to reach out to the manager—he asked the clerk if she knew if Mary Jo had the manager's number. He said he asked for it a few days ago

Trustee Serrago said on her walk around the village (too many talking at once)

Trustee Lasher said the next complaint was from Brud Miller

Trustee Serrago said he has a point about the hedges.

Mayor Bradicich asked where these are

Trustee Lasher said right by my house

Trustee Serrago said there are a few including my neighbor

Mayor Bradicich asked if the potholes were fixed at the municipal parking lot this week?

Trustee Serrago the parking sign-people park as long as they want?

Mayor Bradicich said the bank wants people to be able to get customers in and it not be for for resident parking full time, which I can understand. We have to get the potholes fixed, the 8 North Washington St hedges Mike should be able to talk to the homeowner about and the 10 minute parking sign, I will talk to Brud about this I'm not inclined to do anything about.

Mayor Bradicich asked if we keep track of the complaints on a Spreadsheet or something?

Clerk said they are put into a book

Mayor Bradicich asked if a spreadsheet can be done

Clerk said she will speak to Mary Jo

Mayor Bradicich said he just wants a spreadsheet to know who took what action, to do what and what the follow up is.

Clerk said okay and confirmed that she is telling mike about the mowing and the hedges.
Mayor Bradicich said yes please

Mayor bradicich asked Trustee Lasher if there was anything else?

Trustee Lasher said that the Street festival would like to put up the banner

Mayor Bradicich asked if a resolution needed to be made

Trustee Lasher said she didn't think so. She did say she still hadn't received the contract for the police department so that it can be signed.

Mayor Bradicich asked if the 2% increase had been given
Trustee Lasher said (inaudible) the second part had to go to the union guy. Other wise we will get a crossed out one.

Mayor Bradicich said to CC him on the email and I will follow up, it's going to hurt them more than us. He then asked when do we do the uniform cleaning?

Trustee Lasher said they received it.

Mayor Bradicich said so we paid this.

Trustee Lasher said it was due on June 1st.

Clerk said they received it a week late, but they received it.

Mayor Bradicich said Let's get it documented so we get a date.

Trustee Lasher said the MJ is getting together paperwork for the police vehicle. And the cars are backing up again at Dennis's garage.

Mayor Bradicich said he spoke with Mike about that last week—It's not lets go write them up and forget about it, it's a coordinated effort between him and police. It's got to be a month of putting the heat on, I'll stay on top of Mike you stay on top of Roger as well.

Trustee Lasher asked do you want me to say anything to Roger about being more visible up there by Bruce?

Mayor Bradicich said I mean yeah we should add it to the scope it is the village. The problem is, we aren't going to be up there enough to make Bruce happy. But, it needs to be done. Park up on River Road once a week for a couple of hours. I worry about this side as well. I think there is something to be said about an Athens Police Officer when pulling into Athens. I would argue more at Brick Row, but let's (inaudible)

Attorney Rapplyea said I did a search(Inaudible)

Mayor Bradicich said he is passionate about it-Best answer take a look at it.

Trustee Serrago said there has been a lot of speeding on Second Street lately, it's outrageous lately the last couple of months.

Mayor Bradicich said that's something I've said a couple times—vary the time.

The clerk asked to speak as a resident—she said the speeding on Schoharie Tpke is terrible too. 6-10am when school is in session. She saw 4 cars come down the hill 3 were

doing the speed limit and the 4th decided to pass the 3 on the double line. There are kids and animals out there.

Mayor Bradicich said if we make it a priority we will change behavior the problem is we have 1 police car running at a time Sheriff, State Police we can reach out to and tell we have a problem in these areas and ask them to help us out.

Mayor Bradicich said vary policing hrs with a focus on Second and Schoharie Reach out to Sheriff and State ask for help in those areas and 1 to 2 hours down by River Road. Roger is going to be against this.

Trustee Serrago said I do think we need help from County and State—we can't be everywhere.

Mayor Bradicich said let's ask the County to help us out

Trustee Scott said he pretty much covered everything. I did put feelers out for a DPW committee. I only had 1 person express interest. I was hoping to get a few more.

Trustee Serrago I found out that the .gov needs to be registered thru .gov .gov a governmental site would cost \$400.00 a year. We can look into it. Someone in Panama owns the other web address. I cant get under \$200.00. I'm looking at Athens Village NY or Instagram . About the lawn mowing, I also did not get the schedule from him I asked for.

Mayor Bradicich said they've been let go for too long

Trustee Serrago said If they are that high don't you need a brush hog? The dog park is good-We need to make some kind of a path by the pond because it floods out. I don't know if we have money.

Mayor Bradicih asked Amy of she signed the lawn mowing guys voucher and if he charged for everything this week.

Trustee Serrago said not for everything this week.

Mayor Bradicich said he wrote what he considered a nasty note

Trustee Serrago said she wants to do more than chase down the lawn mower guy

Trustee Lasher said that the dog park has money and it can be used and the fence needs work...go for a community grant.

Mayor Bradicich agreed that that was a good idea.

Trustee Serrago said if people knew and if they were excited about it we may get help.

Mayor Bradicich said I drove past there before leaving last week and as I pulled up Athens Pd was there and someone tossed a bag of garbage. I picked it up not something we will bring up to the police, just disappointed police didn't take care of it.

Trustee Lasher said we should look into it

Mayor Bradicich said we are running out of our 3 community grant applications.

Trustee Lasher asked if he remembered which ones they were.

Mayor Bradicich said one was for the police computer, which the dept did not get

Trustee Scott explained the TRAKS program

Mayor Bradicich said that Roger didn't think they needed it for the amount that is done here.

Trustee Scott said he agrees

Mayor Bradicich said the computer would let them know when pulling up to a call whether or not there was a restraining order—they have to be able to see restraining orders they have to do something.

Attorney Rappelyea said he looked into the Local law for tax breaks for Commercial Properties—he said there is nothing there for tax breaks (inaudible) he said he also spoke with the bank on the Maurer property. Once they release the lien they won't have any interest.

Trustee Serrago asked who owns the land when they are done.

Trustee Scott said he thought Michael Maurer—by that time we get the release have it demolished and relevel onto the property taxes.

Mayor Bradicich asked if the County then pays us.

Attorney Rappelyea said yes

Trustee Lasher asked what ever happened to 1 N Washington St.

Attorney Rappelyea said he started doing cleanup and we did send a violation

Trustee Lasher asked do we have any recourse from the last time.

Attorney Rappelyea said he will bring the file to the next meeting.

Trustee Lasher said that we need to finalize

Clerk said that the recreation counselors were setting training up with Roger and we could schedule with that.
