Welcome to the Village of Athens! We hope you enjoy your time here in the Hudson Valley, but there are a few local rules that we want to make you aware of...

We are small village and our speed limits are strictly enforced. Please help us keep the community safe. Drive carefully!

Please be aware of noise restrictions within the Village. Music, television, etc. should be enjoyed at a reasonable volume. No amplified sound should be audible within 100 feet of any dwelling between the hours of 7am and 11pm, nor should any amplified sound be audible within 50 feet of any dwelling between 11pm and 7am. These hours differ slightly from commercial establishments' noise restrictions which run from 10pm to 8am.

When enjoying our local parks please remember to dispose of all trash properly - including pet waste! Trash cans are provided in all Village of Athens parks. Only authorized Village vehicles are allowed to drive into the Riverfront Park and no alcohol is permitted. But, you can enjoy a delicious adult beverage by the water at the Stewart House or sample award winning brews right up the street at Crossroads Brewing Co.

For household trash, please do not use public trash cans or the trash cans of other residents. Your rental host should provide trash removal and cans should not be left on the street/sidewalk for more than 24 hours after pick up.

Please obey all parking regulations, including those for snow emergencies in winter. There is no parking permitted in our alleyways and vehicles should park in the direction of traffic flow.

The Village of Athens is a dog friendly community. However, dogs must be leashed at all times in all public areas (including parks, playgrounds, streets and sidewalks). While you're here, be sure to visit the Bunker Hill dog park located at 84 Union St. to let your fur baby stretch her legs and make new friends! And please, pick up after your pet - help keep Athens beautiful.
