BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village Board authorize the acquisition, construction, reconstruction and addition of certain improvements to the Village’s Water Supply and Distribution system,

including, without limitation, land, equipment, machinery, and apparatus relating thereto and replacement of such equipment, machinery and apparatus, stating the estimated maximum cost of said acquisition, construction, reconstruction, addition and replacement together with certain costs preliminary and incidental thereto, is \$1,400,000 appropriating said sum therefor and authorizing the issuance of up to \$1,400,000 serial bonds of the village to finance said appropriation:
